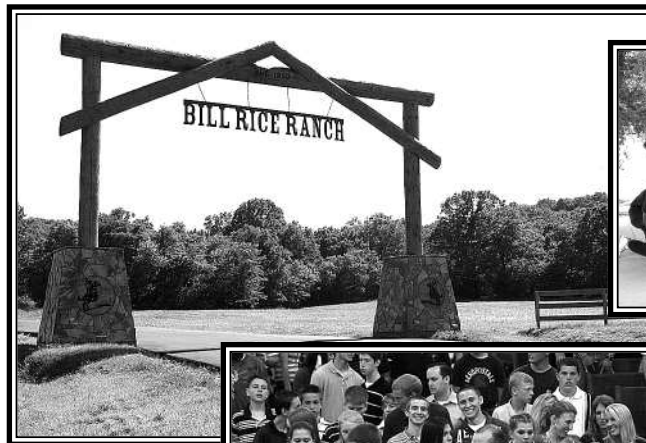

YOUTH WEEK INFORMATION YOU WILL WANT TO KNOW

WHAT TO BRING From its beginning the Ranch has encouraged its guests to honor the Lord in appearance. Wholesome standards displaying modesty and distinction between the sexes are intended to be a help and blessing to you. Men and boys bring sport clothes for play and services. Jeans are fine but no shorts please. Women and girls bring skirts, dresses, and culottes/split skirts of proper length (knee-length) and fullness. No shorts, slacks, capris or gauchos. Everyone will need a Bible, notebook, pen, bedding (bunk beds), towels, washcloths, swimsuit (no two-piece suits), and other personal items. Bedding, towels and washcloths may be rented at camp. You will need money for: Cowboy Cookouts and Trail Rides (\$4.00-\$12.00), Snacks, Souvenirs, Books, CDs, etc. Please DO NOT Bring Radios, CD/MP3/DVD players, skate-boards, bikes, or rollerblades. No smoking. No pets.

SERVICES It is a real privilege to see the Lord work in the lives of young people. You will enjoy the services. The skits, choir, music and preaching make the Ranch

services a unique and blessed experience.

ACTIVITIES There will be swimming, trail rides, hikes, cookouts, putt-putt golf (Branding Iron Greens), special daily activities, sports tournaments, and the famous Bill Rice Ranch Rodeo. Every Friday following the evening meal, the awards will be presented to the top contestants in music and sports, highlighting a great week. You will enjoy the unique 1880s Cowboy Town where you can browse through the souvenir shops, have your picture made in a western setting, enjoy snacks, or purchase postcards and stamps. There is always something to do.

Boys: No shorts. Sweat pants or running suits will not be appropriate for meals or services. **Girls:** No shorts, slacks, capris or gauchos. Skirts, dresses and culottes/split skirts must be knee-length and of proper fullness. Skirts or dresses are required in the mornings and evenings. This would include all meals and services. Culottes of proper length and fullness should be worn only in the afternoons for sports and other activities.

MUSIC CONTESTS Interstate competition includes vocal

solo, vocal group (maximum 6), instrumental (includes solo or groups of 6 or less and piano duets), piano solo, and choir (7 or more). All contestants must register at 7:30 P.M. on Sunday to participate. The vocal solo elimination contest will follow the Sunday evening service, and the final vocal solo contest will be in the second service Monday morning. Both elimination and final contests will be conducted daily in various categories. Write for complete details of the contests. Ribbons are awarded to first, second, and third-place winners. The Princess Trophy is awarded to the first-place choir.

SPORTS Interstate competition in sports is a highlight of the week of camp. There are interstate tournaments for boys in softball, basketball, volleyball and flag football; for girls there is softball, basketball and volleyball. Trophies are awarded to first and second-place winners in each sport. A special trophy is awarded to the group displaying the finest Christian sportsmanship and character during the week. Get your teams ready early to enter the sports tournaments.
